Gestures

Point, wave, smile, laugh, look, stare

at

Everybody **look** at the board please.

She always **smiles** at me.

Everyone **stared** at the man in the pink dress.

I was upset because everyone **laughed** at me.

**at /
to**

The guide **pointed** at / to a painting on the wall

The Queen **waved** at / to the crowds.

Targets

at

My Dad often **shouts/yells** at me when he's angry.

He **shot** at the bird, but he missed.

My teacher **threw** a book at me

I **aimed** at the target and fired.

He **kicked** the ball at my head!

Recipients

to

Throw the ball to me!

Give the money to me!

I **shouted** to the swimmers that there was a shark.

Kick the ball to me!

My team is in **first place**

the middle

I am in **the middle** of a conversation

start

He passed me at **the start** of the race

end

I was really tired at **the end** of the day

at

top

I'm at **the top** of the escalator.

bottom

We are at **the bottom** of the stairs.

front

I am at **the front** of the line.

back

I always sit at **the back** of the classroom

arrive, finish

in

places

We arrived in **Moscow** last night

The bike race finished in **my town**

When did you arrive in **the UK**?

at

We have arrived at **our destination**

We arrived at **the hotel** very late

The marathon finishes at **the palace**
